<p><b>Project Objectives</b> What do you want students to learn? <i>This includes skills &amp; core standards</i></p>	
<p><b>Guiding Question(s)</b> What are the essential or driving questions you want students to answer?</p>	
<p><b>Assessment</b> How will you measure learning? How will students show what they have learned?</p>	
<p><b>Background Knowledge</b> What is the foundational information that students will need to know BEFORE they begin the project? <i>This is the information that will help them as they work on their project.</i></p>	
<p><b>Student Process</b> What steps do students need to take in order to complete their project? <i>Ex. Identify a problem, Determine how to address the problem, Target Audience, Research (needed information/resources), plan, and carry out plans.</i></p>	
<p><b>Teacher Process</b> How will you scaffold this project for students? <i>Ex. Deadlines, guiding worksheets, instruction, etc.</i> <i>List Resource possibilities</i></p>
